INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE EQUIVALENCIES (revised)

Only HL (high-level) IB exam scores will be considered for course waivers or credit. Thus far, department chairs have approved equivalencies for the following IB exams:

HL BIOLOGY—a score of “4” receives credit for a three-credit, 100-level BIOL course (BIOL 101, 104 or 105); a score of “5” receives credit for BIOL 111; a score of “6” or “7” receives credit for BIOL 110 and BIOL 111.

HL ENGLISH: Language & Literature—a score of “5” receives credit for an English writing elective; a score of “6” or “7” receives credit for WRIT 102 and an ENGL writing elective.

HL ENGLISH: Literature—a score of “5” receives credit for LIT 104; a score of “6” or “7” receives credit for LIT 104 and a 200-level English elective.

HL FILM OR THEATRE— a score of “4,” “5,” “6” or “7” receives credit for a three-credit FNAR elective.

HL HIST. AFRICA—a score of “5,” “6” or “7” receives credit for HIST 105 and HIST 106.

HL HIST. AMERICAN— a score of “5,” “6” or “7” receives credit for HIST 103 and HIST 104.

HL HIST. ASIA/MIDDLE EAST— a score of “5,” “6” or “7” receives credit for HIST 105 and HIST 106.

HL HIST. EUROPE— a score of “5,” “6” or “7” receives credit for HIST 101 and HIST 102.

HL HIST. EUROPE/MIDDLE EAST— a score of “5,” “6” or “7” receives credit for HIST 101 and HIST 102.
