ASTRONOMY IN YOUR OWN BACKYARD

This 5-day course will lead your son or daughter through a hands-on astronomy experience that is as practical as it is fascinating. Join Mr. James Krug, from the Neil Armstrong Planetarium, to learn how to use the night sky as a compass, how to tell time of day and direction with the Sun, learn moon phases, constellations and our planet's place in the Cosmos on the whole. ATHLETIC SPORTS ENHANCEMENT

Join Health and Physical Education teacher, Mr. Douglas Fogel, for a program that is designed to introduce and create foundations of fitness and overall athleticism in a fun, positive and high-success environment. Learn running techniques, athletic coordination, balance, agility, relative muscular strength and endurance, along with the importance of proper nutrition.

BOOK WRITING

By the end of the week you will be rock'n out and performing new dance moves to impress all your friends. Brush off your dancing shoes and join us for a great experience. Dance II camp is the same principle as Dance I although different dances will be introduced. Attendance of Dance I is not required for Dance II. Individuals who have attended Dance I may also attend Dance II.

EEK! ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION FOR KIDS

Become a bird detective, touch a live reptile, catch bugs, learn the survival strategies wildlife use to make it through each season, explore life at a pond. This is just a taste of what you will explore at the Environmental Education for Kids Camp at Saint Francis this summer. Students will be encouraged to become young backyard naturalists by learning that there are fascinating creatures to be found everywhere you look in nature. This camp is presented by employees of the Cambria County Conservation Office in Ebensburg, PA.
