The *Spring Break in Paris* program provides students with firsthand education about the culture and history of Paris while practicing French language skills in a real-life setting. The program is intended for French majors and French minors, who will earn 3-6 credits towards the study abroad requirement upon successful completion of the program. The program is also open to any student who has already completed FREN 112 or FREN 102, and who will therefore have elementary skills in French; students who are taking FREN 102 or 112 during the spring semester may enroll pending approval from the instructor.

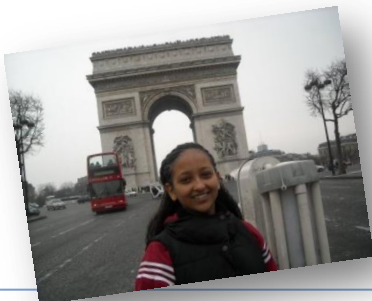


HOUSING AND MEALS

Students will stay in an international dormitory or private hotel in the center of Paris located a few minutes away from most tourist sites. All rooms and quads are equipped with showers and toilets. Breakfast is included; a lunch stipend will be provided. Housing will be in a quiet area close to a metro station.

EXCURSIONS

Cultural activities will include visits to legendary sites in Paris such as the Louvre, Eiffel Tower, Musée d'Orsay, Musée Rodin, Versailles, Pantheon, Opera House and a Seine River cruise. There will be walking tours of the Quartier Latin, Montmartre and the Jewish Quarter. (Excursions subject to availability. Walking shoes are highly recommended.)



DATES AND COSTS

Cost is \$2,400. Price subject to change based on airfares.

- round trip airfare
- metro/bus pass
- room, breakfasts and lunch stipend + a group dinner
- excursions
- medical insurance

Not included:

Some meals, incidental supplies, gifts, and additional fees for change in airline tickets.

Payment Schedule:

- Preliminary payment (\$1,000) due January 11, 2010.
- Balance due February 1, 2010.
