Summer in France

Saint Francis University's Center for International Education and Outreach offers a summer abroad program in France. You will stay in the University's newly-renovated facility in Ambialet, located in southwestern France. The site is perched on a hilltop overlooking the Tarn Valley. You will explore the French countryside, local castles, incredible cathedrals, museums and restaurants all while earning 6 – 7 credits. Athletes may continue their training while in France with biking, running, tennis, kayaking, weightlifting, etc.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Individuals may take 6-7 credits in any combination of the following classes:

- French Language (100 or 200 level) --- 3 credits
 - Modern Art (Fine Arts) ----- 3 credits
 - History (elective) ----- 3 credits
 - Hand Drumming (Fine Arts) ----- 1 or 2 crs.
(1 cr. = 1 week or 2 crs. = 2 weeks)
 - Exploration in the Arts (Fine Arts) ----- 1 credit
- Non credit cooking classes are also available.

HOUSING AND MEALS

You are housed in SFU's site which is located in Ambialet. Ambialet is about 25 minutes from Albi (population 50,000), the largest city in the Tarn region of Southwest France.

Meals are provided; prepare yourself for the fabulous French cuisine!

The program includes excursions to castles, cathedrals and museums throughout the region. A long weekend is schedule for individuals to travel on their own to the place(s) of their choice.
