This 13-day program begins at the University's site in Ambialet. While in Ambialet, you will explore the French countryside, the Christmas market and Basilica Saint Sernin in Toulouse, the Cathedral of Saint Cecil in Albi, the 9th century fort and beautiful village of Coupiac, and the fortified medieval village of Cordes-sur-Ciel. You will then travel to Munich to visit Christmas markets and numerous museums. In Nuremberg you will visit its world-famous Christmas market and other excursions may include the Nazi Party rallying grounds and Albrecht Durer's House.

Program Schedule

- Dec 10: Depart US
- Dec 11: Arrive in Ambialet
- Dec 19: Travel to Munich
With trip to Nuremberg
- Dec 23: Return to US

Program Cost

The program is \$3,000 plus the cost of tuition (\$485 per credit). The costs include airfare, airport transfers, international insurance coverage, excursions, on-site transportation, room accommodations and meals.

Saint Francis University's Site in Ambialet



The University's site is a beautiful renovated historic priory, located in the picturesque Tarn Valley in southwest France. The building overlooks the quaint village of Ambialet. The centuries-old priory has been renovated with modern amenities. Ambialet is about 20 minutes from Albi (population 50,000), the largest city in the Tarn region of southwest France.

Program Course

Requirements to Study Abroad

At the time of application students must have a 2.7 GPA for the semester-long program or a 2.5 GPA for any of the short-term programs (anything lower requires approval from the program director). Passing grades (C or better) in key subject areas may also be required. Students must have successfully completed at least one semester, and preferably one year, at Saint Francis University before studying abroad. Students must demonstrate emotional stability and maturity and indicate the ability to lead a responsible and healthy life abroad as a representative of the U.S. and Saint Francis University. Students must submit the application and all travel forms to the Office for Study Abroad (see application process below) before acceptance into any study abroad program will be considered. Previous health, academic, or disciplinary problems, may influence the decision.

Study Abroad Withdrawal Policy

Withdrawal from any Saint Francis University study or service abroad program must be made in writing and delivered to the Office for Study Abroad in person (306 Scotus Hall) or certified mailed (Saint Francis University, Office for Study Abroad, P.O. Box 600, Loretto, PA 15940). The date in which the withdrawal is received at the Office for Study Abroad will determine the amount of refund.

If you withdraw or are withdrawn from your study abroad program you will receive a refund minus: non-refundable application fee, any non-recoverable portion of the airfare, any non-recoverable program costs such as housing payments and deposits, excursion pre-payments, etc. (The closer the program is to the start date the less recoverable costs will be available). Student withdrawals are not accepted after the start of a program.

If you withdraw from the study abroad program, it is also your responsibility to withdraw from your study abroad courses.

Withdrawals from a study abroad program due to lack of passport and/or visa are held to the same withdrawal policies.
