Who We Are

Saint Francis University is one of the oldest Catholic universities in the United States, and the oldest Franciscan institution of higher education in the country. PEACE Partner Admission Criteria

All graduates from a PEACE member school receive guaranteed admission and scholarship awards. A minimum 3.0 GPA or 85% average is required for general programs, with weighted consideration given to specialized or accelerated programs.

PEACE Member Scholarships

Class of 2026 students are eligible for Academic & Merit Scholarships starting at \$92,000 over four years, plus additional Franciscan and PEACE awards for qualifying applicants.
