Functional Mechanics: A Return to the Intricacies of Movement and How Rehabilitation is Affected

Healthcare practitioners typically receive instruction on mechanics of the musculoskeletal system throughout their education. However, once in clinical practice, many of those foundational concepts are disregarded.
