The following is a projection of costs for a physician assistant student based on current charges (for students enrolling for the first time in 2019-2020), put in a worksheet format so that you can add your own expenses and project what your costs may be. Life style varies from individual to individual and, therefore, the expenses will vary from student to student.

All institutions raise tuition and other expenses periodically and, not having a crystal ball, we can only share with you that tuition may go up in years to come.

You can calculate your own expenses according to your entry level into the Program, allowing for extras such as clothing, entertainment, etc. The room and board figure for the first four years is the school charge for a double room with “platinum” board; if you live off campus or in different campus housing, you may find the costs to be different. The clinical year room and board is an average based on a survey of clinical students.

Students are expected to provide their own reliable transportation during the didactic year and it is necessary to have a car during the clinical year due to the travel necessary to and from rotation sites.
