I'm excited to invite you to the 32nd Annual STEAM Day at Saint Francis University, taking place on Tuesday, November 25, 2025. Registration kicks off at 8:00 a.m. in the DeGol Arena with an activities fair, and the welcome begins at 9:00. Throughout the day, we'll have a variety of engaging presentations starting at 9:30, 10:30, 11:30, and 12:30. Each student will register by indicating their intended college major and preferred sessions to attend. Additionally, all high school students and teachers will enjoy lunch on campus during one of the final three hours.

We ask that the main contact teacher for each school register through the Teacher Registration link in the STEAM Day invitation email. ***Please complete this form by Friday, October 31, 2025.*** Teachers are welcome to attend any sessions and don't need to choose in advance. We only need one teacher per school to fill out the form, which should include the names of any other teachers attending. The SFU Education Department will be hosting a Teacher Meet and Greet from 9:30am-10:20am in Library 305. Also, Sarah Bramley, IU-8 Curriculum STEM Specialist, will host a session for teachers.

Students should go to the same website to access the Student Registration form (<https://www.francis.edu/steam-day>). We ask all students to attend at least one of the four Featured Presentations, so please ensure they select at least one. Students will then choose five additional sessions they are interested in; each student will be assigned to three sessions and lunch during the four available slots. Please encourage students to read the session descriptions on the STEAM Day website so they can make informed choices. Also, on the STEAM Day site, there are PDF's that group the sessions by hashtags so students can easily identify interest areas. We'll do our best to honor their preferences, but please note that session assignments will depend on room capacity and demand. Their intended college major will also help us place them in sessions relevant to their interests. ***Please have all students registered by Friday, October 31, 2025.***

This year's Featured Presentations include: exploring AI, NASA and military service, STEAM student panel, and how to unlock your creativity. Alongside these, we have 34 additional sessions, including some popular favorites from past years and new offerings—so there's something for everyone!
