Priority scheduling
Enlarged tests
Movement breaks

Moving classrooms to ensure accessibility

Other accommodations

Provide wheelchairs when needed
Handicap parking
University police will provide transportation to individuals with disabilities
Interpreting services to those visiting the campus
Dietary needs will be addressed through dining services
Air condition units may be appropriate to those living on campus
